



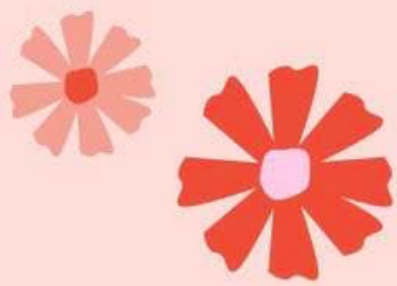

What is Period Poverty?



It is defined as the lack of access to safe and hygienic menstrual products during monthly periods and inaccessibility to basic sanitation services or facilities as well as menstrual hygiene education.



In Arkansas, the average lifetime cost for period products is \$11,000, and 1 in 4 women who need the products struggle to afford them.



About 16.9 million menstruating women in the United States live in poverty, two-thirds are low-income and food-insecure women who cannot afford basic menstrual products such as pads, tampons, and menstrual products.
