
WHAT IS PERIOD POVERTY?

DEFINED AS: A LACK OF ACCESS TO MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS, HYGIENE FACILITIES, WASTE MANAGEMENT, AND EDUCATION

500 MILLION PEOPLE LACK ACCESS TO MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS AND HYGIENE FACILITIES

TWO-THIRDS OF THE 16.9 MILLION LOW-INCOME WOMEN IN THE US COULD NOT AFFORD MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS IN THE PAST YEAR, WITH A HALF OF THIS NEEDING TO CHOOSE BETWEEN MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS AND FOOD.

14.2 % OF COLLEGE MENSTRUATING PEOPLE IN THE US HAVE EXPERIENCED PERIOD POVERTY IN THE PAST YEAR



WHAT CAN YOUR DONATION DO?

INDIVIDUALIZED BAGS:

- EACH BAG WILL CONSIST OF 8 TAMPONS, 8 PADS, AND 8 PANTY LINERS
