I have also realized that not a lot of assisted living facilities in our area are familiar and comfortable when dealing with this disease. She has been labeled many times as a fall risk and a potential liability, resulting in her being removed from some of these facilities. Throughout my nursing career, I want to be able to promote Parkinson's awareness and to help begin to provide better care for people with this chronic disease.

Also, while being introduced to many different nursing fields in high school, I was able to have a rotation in the operation room— I IMMEDIATELY fell in love. I have been blessed to stand in on many operations since then where I have seen some of the anatomy that we read and study come to life. I enjoy the anesthesia side to operation rooms because it would still gives me access to patient care and to perform some critical thinking skills.
